Frosh/Soph-JV Soccer -The Frosh/Soph and JV team's goal is to give all players more playing time while learning the skills needed to play at the Varsity level. This is a great opportunity for the boys to learn teamwork which is an important part of being on a team. Frosh/Soph might be asked to move up to JV and JV players may be asked to move up to Varsity at some point during the season due to situations like performing well at that level or injuries at the Varsity level. Game time participation is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the coaching staff.

Varsity Soccer - The players that give us the best chance to win the game will play, regardless of age or class. Freshmen have made the Varsity and played at the Varsity level over the years. We do aim to get all players in every game, but it may not always happen. The coaching staff determines which players are the best choice to play in each game. Game time participation is not guaranteed and is at the discretion of the coaching staff. The team you start the season on is not necessarily the team you will stay on all season. A player may also be asked to play for Frosh/Soph, JV or Varsity teams throughout the season. Your performance at practice and games determines team and playing time.

Player Expectations and Guidelines:

1. **Academics**: Players must maintain a 2.0 GPA and complete all schoolwork. Studying is not an excuse to miss practice.
2. **Attendance & Punctuality**: Players must attend all practices and games. Being early is required—"10 minutes early, you're late!"
3. **Game Day Uniforms**: Game uniforms will be indicated by the head coach of each team. Players may need additional attire for school on game days.
4. **Respect**: Players must respect teammates, coaches, officials, and opponents.
5. **Conduct**: Misconduct will be handled directly with the player and can result in team consequences.

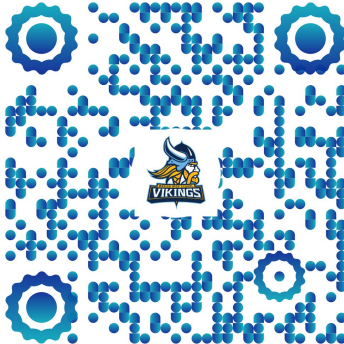
Game Schedule / Transportation

Practice/Game schedules are posted on the Google Calendar, Game schedules will also be posted on the Marina Soccer website, and the school website.

Transportation to and from the non league and league games will be provided by the school. Any 3PM games all players are required to ride the bus if they have a 5th period. All players who ride the bus to the game will return on the bus. In the event that the varsity plays @5pm or later the lower level players are expected to watch and support the Varsity. The program will be providing dinner for them on these away game nights that are late. The coaches will determine if the whole program will be riding the bus so assume you are taking the bus unless you are told otherwise.
